NEW LEGAL FRAMEWORK

Electricity

Directive 2005/89/EC concerning measures to safeguard security of electricity supply and infrastructure investment (due implementation – by the end of 2009)

Gas

Directive 2004/67/EC concerning measures to safeguard security of natural gas supply (due implementation by the end of 2009)

Regulation (EC) 1775/2005 on conditions for access to the natural gas transmission networks (due implementation by the end of 2008)

- **DECISION 2008/03/MC – Energy Community
11.12.08**

"NETWORK ENERGY" NOW INCLUDES ALSO OIL SECTOR (FURTHER TO ELECTRICITY AND GAS), i.e. supply, trade, processing and transmission of crude oil and petroleum products falling within the scope of European Community Directive 2006/67/EC and the related pipe-lines, storage, refineries and import/export facilities".

- **DECISION 2008/03/MC – Energy Community
11.12.08**

SHALL WE IMPLEMENT NEW ACQUIS - For the implementation of Title II of the Treaty in relation with the oil sector, the relevant elements of the Acquis Communautaire and their timetable for implementation shall be defined pursuant Article 100 (ii) of the Treaty by 30 June 2010

NOT RELEVANT FOR - This does not apply to Articles 21 to 23 (Generally Applicable Standards) and to Articles 43 (Measures to regulate import and export in relation to Network Energy) and 44 to 46 of the Treaty (Mutual Assistance in case of disruptions).
